



TEODORS BERGTĀLS

(Born in 1886, Laubezere parish; died in 1942, Solikamsk)

**Deputy of the Chief Prosecutor of the Senate (1938),
Senator of the Administrative Department (1938–1940)**

Education: Riga Theological Seminary; University of Warsaw, Faculty of Law.

Before the Senate: worked in the State Audit Office of Russia; Deputy of the Prosecutor;
Judge and Deputy of the Chair of the Riga Regional Court.

After the Senate: Arrested in 1941 and taken to Solikamsk prison camps, sentenced to death
