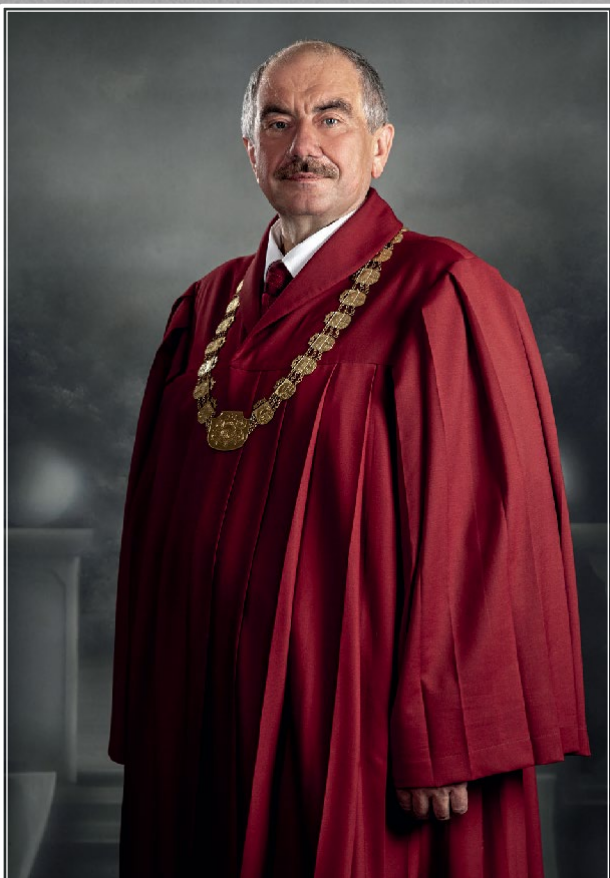


Ivars BIČKOVIČS
